

#### The most important facts in brief

- Race numbers for all categories,
   Self-service at the Event Center (EC)
- Route to the start: 2,2 km, 210 m elevation, approx. 45 min (not illuminated)
- 2 Mobile toilets at the start
- Clothes transport from start to finish
- Pre-start 4 min before start time
- → Please allow plenty of time!

Race Numbers	For all categories, self-service at the Event Center (EC)			



Mutations	Change of SI-Card number only on race day at the information desk in the EC → No others mutations are accepted.		
Start list	Will be published about 1 week before the event on www.swiss-orienteering.ch and on ol-events.ch		
Route to the start	2.2 km, 210 m elevation, approx. 45 min.		
Transport of clothes / WC	Directly from the start to the finish 2 Mobile toilets at the pre-start (no random peeing anywhere in the start area!)		
Pre-start	<ul> <li>Entering the starting area (call-up),         clear and check the SI-Card</li> <li>Self-service of control descriptions</li> <li>Personal preparation</li> <li>Start check, step to the map box,         the category is visible on the map</li> <li>take the correct map, good luck!</li> </ul>		
Start / Starting point	Time start (without punching) according to the start list  → Distance to the starting point: 20m (standard flag without SI-Unit)		
Controls	White-orange flag as per RC with SI-units (AIR+ activated)  → If the SI-Unit don't work or is not there, punch a hole in the map with the pliers  → If the SIAC does not respond, stamp the unit		
Special features	<ul> <li>Pasture fences of any kind (wire, barbed wire, cattle guards) are not mapped         → In the terrain, they are occasionally marked with tape in places for better visibility         → some of them may still be under power!         <ul> <li>small electricity pylons and telephone poles incl. lines are not mapped</li> <li>Narrow rides are only mapped with the 508 symbol if the lanes are clearly visible on the ground</li> <li>On the longer courses cows may still be in the pastures</li> <li>Caution: sometimes there are many controls in a small space</li> <li>On the Control descriptions, bushes are shown as a special object (circle)</li> <li>→ Fence damages must be reported at the finish</li> </ul> </li> </ul>		
Out of bounds areas	They are marked on the map → Disregard leads to disqualification.		
Refreshments	2 Water refreshing points occupied by staff (symbolized by a cup on the map)		
Finish	Punching SI-unit on the finish line by yourself.  → Maps will be collected at the finish.  They can be picked up at the EC approx. 20 minutes after the last start.		
Maximum time/ Finish closing time	150 minutes, finish closing time 150 minutes after the last start		





Back to the Event Center	1,5 km, approx. 20 min		
SI-Card download	At the EC → Runners who give up <b>must</b> report back to the EC for evaluation!		
First Aid	At the EC		
Awards ceremony	In the event center (EC) appr. from 22:00  → Prizes in kind for the top three in all categories.  Additional prize money for the Grand Slam categories D/H20 and D/HE.		
Results	Online result lists at <u>ol-events.ch.</u> The official results will be available after the race at <u>www.swiss-orienteering.ch</u> .		
Protests	Before submitting a complaint, the organiser (competition judge) must be consulted in order to settle the matter amicably. If no amicable solution is found, the protest must be submitted in writing to the information desk no later than one hour after the closing of the finish, using the available form there.  Persons submitting a protest need to remain at the disposal of the race jury.
